WIMBISH BUS TIMES For users of Tye Green & White Hart stops	<p>Notes School buses for high school students (413, 414 & 453) are public service routes. Anyone may use them and bus passes are valid for the afternoon runs. Buses provided for primary school children are not for public use.</p> <p>To use the DART2 service you must make a reservation at least two hours in advance Phone 01621 874411 (Arrow taxis). Bus passes are valid on all these services.</p> <p>DART2 journeys can be booked to take small groups to many local destinations including Audley End Station between 06:00 and 20:00 Monday – Saturday. Phone and enquire.</p> <p>While it is possible to go to Thaxted or Dunmow it is not possible to come home again on the same day, unless you use the schoolday-only bus 453 leaving for Thaxted early in the morning and continue to Dunmow on service 313.</p> <p>While service 313a passes ALDI it does not stop there. Use DART2 and ask to be dropped off at ALDI</p>

Carver Barracks BUS TIMES	<p>NOTE for Carver Barracks bus users</p> <p>School buses for high school students (413 & 453) are public service routes. Anyone may use them and bus passes are valid for the afternoon runs. Buses provided for primary school children are not for public use.</p> <p>There are no timetabled DART2 services but journeys can be booked to take small groups to local destinations including Audley End Station. Note: to use the DART2 service you must make a reservation at least two hours in advance. Phone 01621 874411 (Arrow taxis). The service is available 06:00 – 20:00 Monday – Saturday. Bus passes are valid on all these services after 09:00 (all day Saturday)</p> <p>Although there appear to be a fair number of buses, for trips to and from Saffron Walden no bus goes to Tesco and the buses that pass Aldi do not stop there. On non-school days there is only one return trip to Walden, giving two hours in the town centre. The service to Dunmow (Tesco) and Thaxted (Friday market and local shops) is a bit better.</p>									

Using Buses for longer journeys

The timetabled services from Wimbish only permits trips to Walden and back, spending a couple of hours in town. From Carver Barracks, short visits to Thaxted or Dunmow are possible. It is unlikely that anyone with access to a car would choose to use these services even if they have a free bus pass.

For longer journeys buses may make a good choice provided you can get to Linton (for journeys to Cambridge and beyond) or Debden/Thaxted (for journeys to Stansted Airport, rail to London, a buses to main Essex towns).

Cambridge

Do not use the service 7 from Walden: it is hourly, takes a long, slow route and stops running early in the evening.

Linton has easy, free on-street parking and a half-hourly fast bus service (13/X13) to Addenbrooks and central Cambridge. There are good, fast bus connections to Peterborough, Bedford, Milton Keynes, Newmarket & Oxford.

The service 13 runs seven days a week first bus from Linton 06:12 last bus from Cambridge 23:20. This makes it possible to go to the theatre and bus home afterwards.

Stansted Airport

It is incredibly expensive to park at the airport, get a taxi there or pay the drop off charge if you get a lift. If you use Audley End station there is also an expensive car park charge.

Bus service 6 will take you to the airport door for a small fare (free with bus pass) and enable you to use either the Stansted Express train service to London, fast buses, coaches or trains to destinations all over England or fly off to Europe.

Board bus 6 either in **Debden** (outside school) or **Thaxted** (outside post office). There is a free car park in either village or town.

From Thaxted to Airport takes 21 minutes and entire journey to London under 1 hour 20 minutes. The first bus leaves Thaxted at 06:46 and the last leaves Stansted Airport at 21:03 Monday to Saturday.
