Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council meeting held on
17th August, 2017 at 7.30 p.m.
in the Pavilion, Tye Green, Wimbish

The Parish Councillors met at the recreation ground to discuss the positioning of two pieces of adult gym equipment at the recreation ground.

1. **Apologies for Absence:** Ian Porter
2. **Councillors to declare pecuniary interests:** Mark Westbrooke declared a personal interest in the gym equipment.
3. **Public Participation (15 minutes):**

Speeding down Mill Road: VAS isn't working for over 8 months and when it was working the sign was flashing at a number of vehicles. The road is a primary route so physical barriers are not allowed. The PC agreed to try to resurrect speed watch in the village.
Clerk to ask ECC what they would propose to reduce speed and to put in the speed strips to check the speed of the vehicles. The volume of traffic has increased.

Website: David Corke asked for the Wimbish website to be kept up to date. The Clerk has updated all the minutes and agendas and more work will be carried out on the website by Judith Bonsor. Judith Bonsor will be asked for usage figures.
4. **To approve the positioning of two pieces of adult gym equipment on the recreation ground.**
(Mark Westbrooke declared a personal interest)
The PC agreed that the adult gym equipment to be situated 25 metres from the children's play area along the side of the car park.
Mark Westbrooke did not agree with the location of the play equipment.

Mark Westbrooke informed the PC that the school had made it clear to the builders that they should only park on the playing field.
